Clear Anti-Slip Surfacing

- For floors to be seen and made safe
- Attractive finish
- Roll of tape

The combination of transparency and positive grip enables floors to be seen and made safe. It can be used in all entrance areas of factories, offices and hospitals, as well as stairs, service areas, corridors and ramps. Apply to a clean dry surface. Product not recommended to use if surface primer is black. If used outdoors an Edge Sealer is recommended.

- Easy to apply with uniform coverage
- Ideal for interior and exterior untreated timber, concrete, primed metal, brick & clay pavers
- Residential applications include small projects, stairs and railings. Not recommended for driveways
- Industrial applications include stairs, entrances and **exit way**
- Not suitable for surfaces where vehicles are in use. For **use with foot traffic only**

Surface Preparation:

Clean surface of all dirt, grease, oil, salt and chemical contaminants. Remove any loose rust and flaking paint. Smooth, hard or glossy surfaces should be sanded to create a surface profile.

Concrete: For best results all concrete surfaces should be etched. New concrete surfaces should be cured for 4-6 weeks. For high porous surfaces apply one coat of an appropriate sealer.

Metal: For best results all metal surfaces must be primed with a suitable primer.

Coverage Approximately 3-6 m² per litre for Safety Yellow. Approximately 5-10m² per litre for Clear and Black. Drying Time Touch dry in 6-8 hours (25°C). Recoat after 24-36 hours (Depending on film thickness). Walk on in 24-48 hours.
